The Hub offers a safe space for residents in the Jeff VanderLou, The Ville, and Greater Ville neighborhoods to connect with needed resources to aid in the stabilization and healthy development of families.

Pathways to Progress provides long-term, intensive case management for families experiencing poverty in north St. Louis City (north of MLK) and north St. Louis County. Working with families for 2-4 years, connecting them to resources that enhance individual strengths, develop new skills, and address barriers keeping the members from financial stability. The goal of Pathways to Progress is to strengthen community by creating a pathway for families to increase their ability to live safe, productive and sustainable lives; to educate and empower families to make effective decisions that positively impact their future; and to advocate for systematic and progressive change.

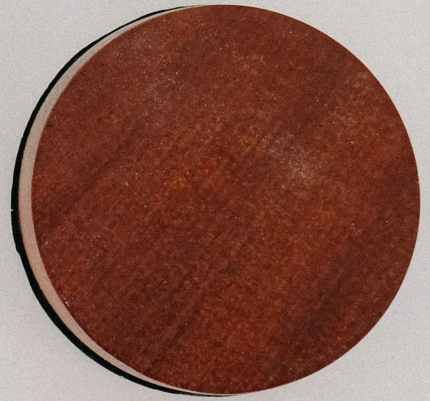

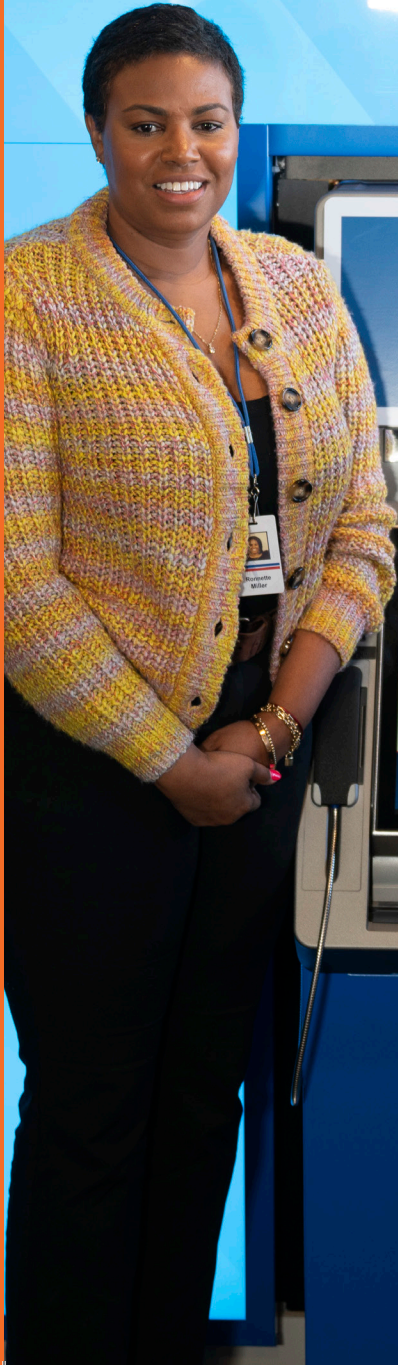
First Bank opened a location in the HUB in November 2022, with full banking services, including second chance banking, access to those living in the community, and the opportunity to build generational wealth.

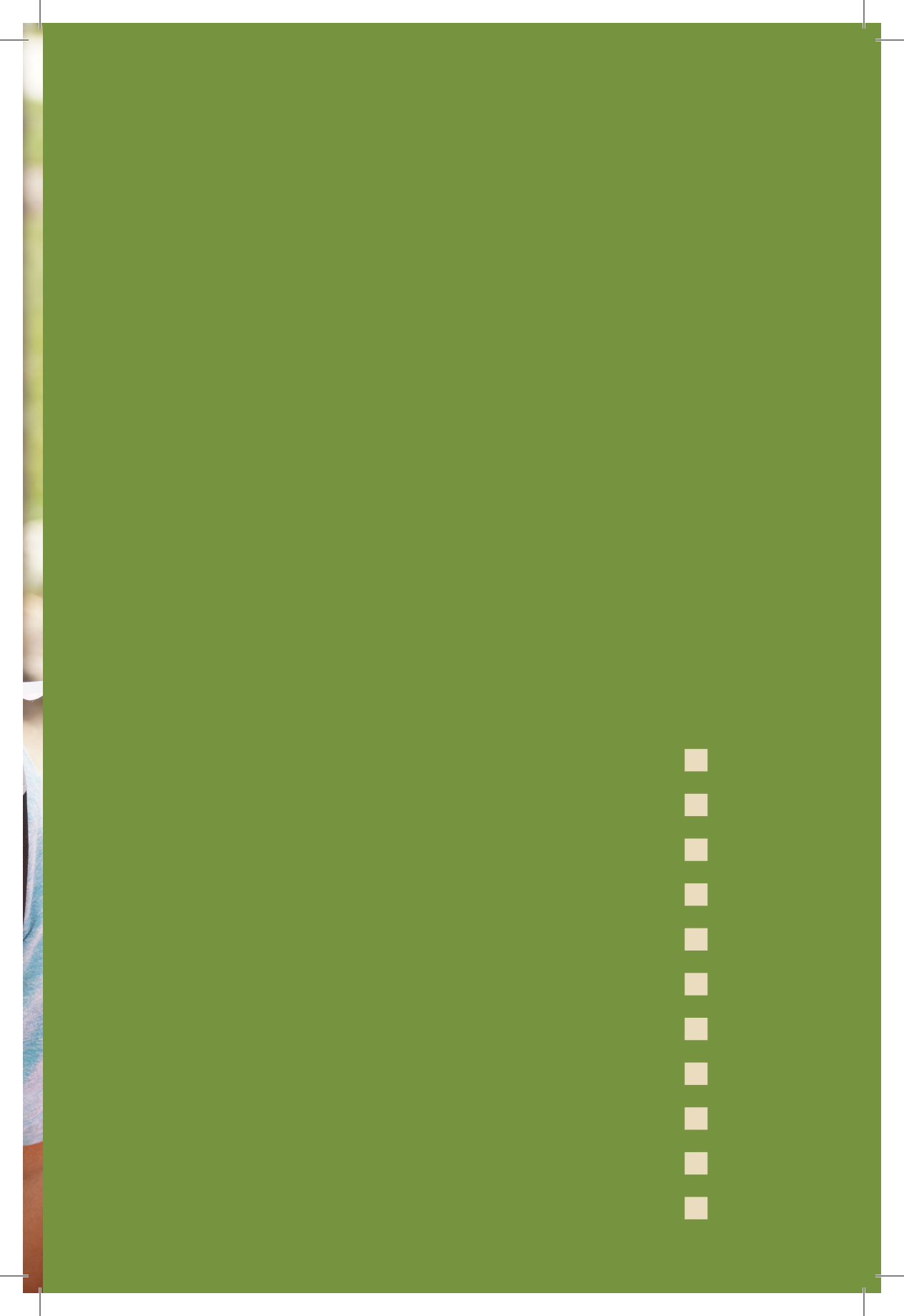
