WALKER SCOTTISH RITE CLINIC OF MARYVILLE UNIVERSITY

The Walker Scottish Rite Clinic, a program of Maryville University, offers free speech-language therapy to children ages 2–6 with speech and language disorders.

The Clinic's KidTalk Outreach program at The Hub serves children both in person and through online sessions. Trained speech-language pathologists evaluate and treat children who have trouble speaking or understanding language.

SERVICES INCLUDE:

- Speech and language screenings and evaluations
- Weekly speech-language therapy
- Hearing checks
- Caregiver training—all provided at no cost to enrolled families.

The Clinic's goal is to support at-risk preschool children who may not qualify for state-funded programs or are unable to afford private therapy.

Program participants learn about more than just music through Pianos for People. This program provides a much-needed outlet for creative minds, while introducing important life skills related to discipline and collaboration.

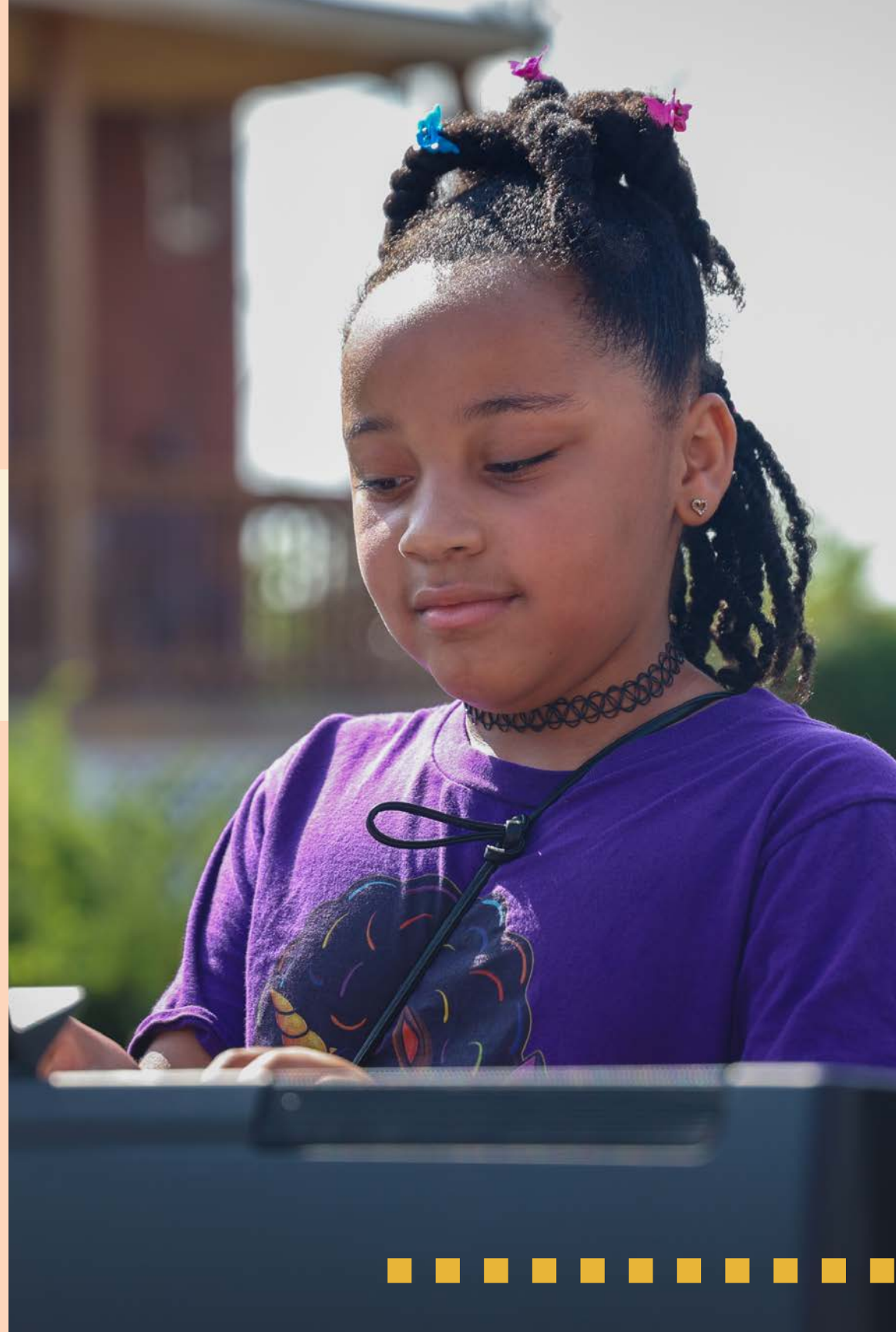
This program gives kids and young adults the opportunity to explore music as a hobby or as a potential career.

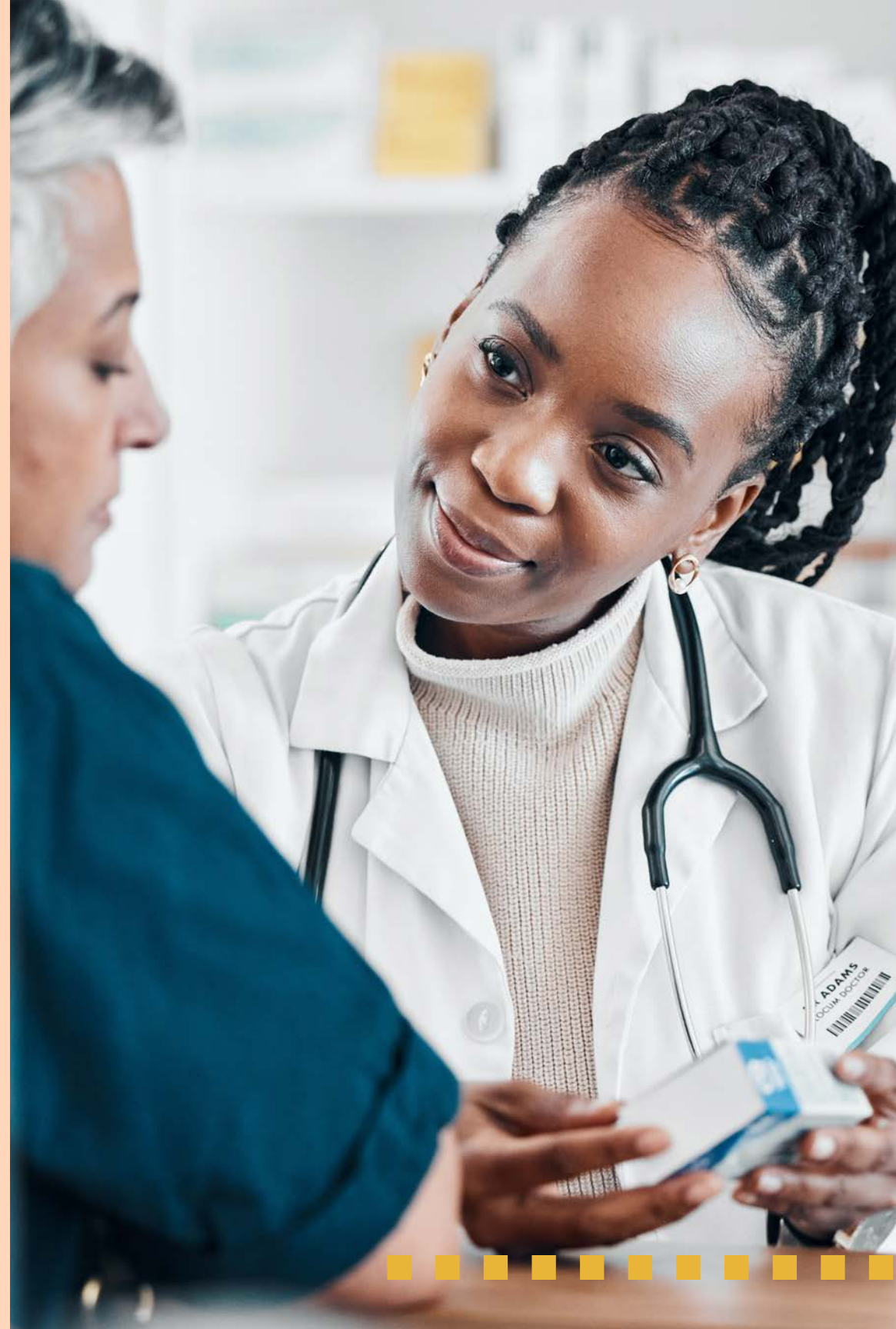
We also partner with Operation Food Search to provide home delivery of healthy foods, promoting medication adherence and lifestyle change.
